

City of Palo Special Council Meeting September 30th, 2014

The Palo City Council met in regular session at Palo Council Chambers on September 30th, 2014. Mayor Tom Yock called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Council Members present: Tom Sanders, Delmar Jellison, Brian Beaty, Ryan Scheckel and Doug Hanover.

Mayor Yock led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hanover moved **approval of agenda** Sanders second. Motion carried. (5-0)

Street Financial Report: Beaty questioned if the skid loader should be on the equipment inventory sheet. Clerk will look into. Council discussed purchasing a small truck this fiscal year for trips to town and driving around town instead of the 1 ton. After further discussion Motion by Jellison to approve Resolution #09-30-14A the Street Financial Report. Hanover second. Roll call. Motion carried (5-0).

Infrastructure Projects. Council discussed road repair projects and looking at hard surfacing the roads throughout the city. Engineer is looking at cost comparison on concrete vs. asphalt. Sanders questioned what areas we are looking at first. Council stated they would make a priority list in the spring with the understanding this could change if other roads incur damage due to frost boils etc. This is on the agenda for the October 20th, 2014 meeting.

Old Business: Hanover stated he will work on getting the case tractor ready and will check with all the scrap yards and take it to the highest bidder. Yock stated he will contact car dealerships to look at replacing the dodge truck.

Motion by Hanover to **adjourn** at 7:55p.m., Beaty second. Motion carried. (4-0).
